PRE-RAMADAN MEDICAL OUTREACHES

COLLABORATION WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS IKORODU, LAGOS STATE

HCFI in collaboration with The Muslim Congress Lagos State organized a Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan on 2nd February, 2025 at the TMC Ikorodu Dawah Center Lagos Lagos State. The total number of patients attended to were 245, while the number of medical personnel present were 8. Patients were screened and treated for various health conditions, all drugs were provided free of charge.

Investigation done include BMI, blood pressure, H. Pylori test, RBS /FBS

COLLABORATION WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS IGBOGBO BAYEKU LCDA LAGOS

HCFI in collaboration with TMC Igbogbo Bayeku LCDA organized a Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan on Saturday, 8th February, 2025 at Igbe-lara central mosque Igbogbo Bayeku. About of 300 people were attended to and health education was also provided. Medical tests provided include blood pressure, hepatitis B, Fasting Blood Sugar and H. *Pylori* tests. Nine HCFI volunteers were present.

COLLABORATION WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS, LAGOS STATE

HCFI in collaboration with The Muslim Congress Lagos State organized a Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan on Sunday, 9th February, 2025 at the TMC Dawah Center Ijesha Lagos State. The total number of patients attended to were 136, while the number of medical personnel present were Six. Patients were screened and treated for various health conditions, all drugs were provided free of charge.

Tests carried out include Fasting Blood Sugar/Random Blood Sugar - 150 clients, Urinalysis - 100 clients, Health talk was given by Dr Akegbeyale Abdulateef

PRE RAMADAN MEDICAL CARAVAN WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS SHOMOLU LOCAL GOVERNMENT

A Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan was organized in collaboration with TMC Shomolu Local Government on Sunday, 16th February, 2025. The venue was Akoka Central

Mosque, 51 Sholanke Street, Akoko Lagos. Investigation carried out include: Blood pressure, blood sugar, H. *Pylori* test, and urinalysis. A total number of 137 persons were catered for. Six HCFI volunteers were in attendance.

PRE RAMADAN MEDICAL CARAVAN IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS KOSOFE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND MARKAZ NAHDAH CENTER FOR ARABIC AND ISLAMIC STUDIES, GBAGADA

A Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan was organized in collaboration with the above organizations on Sunday, 16th February, 2025. The venue was old Bariga LCDA office, opposite YTK filling station, new garage, Bariga. Investigation carried out include : Blood pressure, blood sugar, H. *Pylori* test, and urinalysis. A total number of 157 persons were catered for. Six HCFI volunteers were in attendance.

COLLABORATION WITH TEMIDIREE CENTRAL MOSQUEABULE OKOTA LAGOS

HCFI in collaboration with Temidire Central Mosque organized a Pre-Ramadan Medical Caravan on Sunday, 23rd February, 2025 at Alubarika primary school Abule Okuta Lagos State. The total number of patients attended to were 146, while the number of medical personnel present were eight. The health talk was delivered by Mr Isiaq Saba on importance of medical check up and wellness, patients were screened and treated for various health conditions, all drugs were provided free of charge. Tests carried out include Fasting Blood Sugar/Random Blood Sugar, Urinalysis and *H.pylori*

RAMADAN MEDICAL OUTREACHES

COLLABORATION WITH ISLAMIC MEDICAL ASSOCIATION OF NIGERIA (IMAN) LAGOS STATE CHAPTER FOR RAMADAN MEDICAL OUTREACHES (BARAKAH TRAIN)

HCFI members attended and participated actively during the Islamic Medical Association of Nigeria (IMAN) Lagos State chapter medical outreach throughout the month of Ramadan 1447AH.

OTHER MEDICAL OUTREACH PROGRAMMES

COLLABORATION WITH UNIVERSITY OF LAGOS GREEN HUB

A medical outreach for Waste Workers was organized in collaboration with the University of Lagos Green Hub and the Africaan Network of Technology and Engineering Researchers on Teusday March 18, 2025 to commemorate the World Recycling Day. The venue was Olusosun Landfill Ojota Lagos.

Investigation carried out include : Blood pressure and blood sugar tests , A total number of 152 persons were catered for. Five HCFI volunteers were in attendance medical personnel. A public lecture on healthy living was delivered by the ED, HCFI Prof Ibrahim Oreagba

COLLABORATION WITH YABA COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY, ALBASAR INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION AND YABA LCDA FOUNDATION

HCFI collaborated with YABATECH, in partnership with Albasar International Foundation and Yaba LCDA Foundation, to organize the 3rd Medical Outreach Program, providing eye care support for residents of YABATECH host communities. The outreach took place from May 21–26, 2025 at Iwaya Palace, Iwaya Lagos Nigeria. Free eye check-ups, glasses, medication, and cataract surgeries were offered by global experts. Al-Basar is an international charitable and humanitarian NGO that manages Makkah Specialist Eye Hospitals. The Foundation works for the establishment of specialized eye care centers, conduct of free mobile eye services and school eye health projects towards control of blindness and treatment of eye diseases in developing countries with particular emphasis in Africa and Asia.

COLLABORATION WITH THE MUSLIM CONGRESS, LAGOS STATE

HCFI organized a medical outreach in collaboration with TMC Lagos state, held on 29th June 2025 at Lagos State Development and Property Coorporation (LSDPC) Estate, Isolo. Screening/Test carried out include: PSA, MP (RDT), Blood Sugar and Vitals (Blood pressure and weight). Approximately 25 individuals were screened for Postrate Specific Antiden (PSA), an index of potential prostrate enlargement or cancer,

and another 25 for malaria. Mosquito nets and antimalarials were prescribed and distributed free of charge accordingly. About Seventy (70) patients benefitted from the outreach

COLLABORATION WITH ZAKAT AND SADAQAT FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT FLOOD VICTIMS IN MOKWA NIGER STATE

.HCFI participated in a medical outreach organized by Zakat and Sadaqat Foundation in collaboration with Human Appeal United Kingdom on Saturday 28th July and Sunday 29th July at the IDP camp 1 and 2, Mokwa town. Niger State.

More than 500 persons were treated for the two days. Laboratory investigations include: MP, RDT, HIV, Blood sugar and blood pressure. Several patients were referred to General Hospital Mokwa and Mokwa Primary Health Care centre for follow up management. Drugs and medical consumables worth over N5,000,000.00 were utilized for the outreach.

Challenges include the following :

1. Over 96% of the patients were previously diagnosed with peptic ulcer coupled with malnutrition and multidimensional disease conditions.
2. Shortage of manpower toward the end of the outreach due to unplanned extension of the outreach to cater for more people

HCFI COLLABORATION WITH LAGOS STATE BLOOD TRANSFUSION SERVICE (LSBTS)

HCFI collaborated with Lagos State Blood Transfusion Service to mark the blood donor awareness week at General Hospital, Odan Lagos

A webinar themed “Digital transformation of Lagos state blood transfusion service” and topic was “Operational process of the LSBTS blood inventory management system (Hemocentral)” A blood donation drive was hosted by TMC Bariga LCDA on Saturday, 21st July, 2025. The enlightenment lecture was titled “Be a lifesaver: the role of blood donation in emergency and everyday care”

PARTICIPATION AT THE ISLAMIC MEDICAL ASSOCIATION OF NIGERIA (IMAN) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE AND MEDICAL/SURGICAL OUTREACHES 2025

HCFI members attended the Islamic Medical Association of Nigeria (IMAN) Annual General Meeting and Scientific Conference and medical/surgical outreaches December 2-7, 2025, Kaduna State. The Executive Director, HCFI, Prof Ibrahim Oreagba is also the National President of IMAN. HCFI facilitated the road trip by raising over N1,600,000 through our volunteers within the country and in the diaspora

WELFARE ACTIVITIES

HOSPITAL SUPPORT

HCFI raised the sum N4,000,085.00 to support the Hip Replacement Surgery and Post Surgery Treatment of a patient Toheeb Saka. The surgery was successfully carried out in April 2025 at the National Orthopaedic Hospital Dala Kano, Nigeria
HCFI raised over N1,000,000.00 to support the physiotherapy care of another patient Alh Salami who had been bed ridden for over two years. He is however showing significant sign of progress since the commencement of the physiotherapy

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

HCFI spent over N490,000.00 to support 7 students for their undergraduate education in the year under review.
